Russia supplies an estimated 10.5 million cubic metres of timber annually around the world. With Russian shipments now being turned away from most global ports, this is inevitably going to lead to shortages in timber. During the Covid crisis of last year there was exceptional world demand for timber which drove up prices. Although timber has dropped in price over the past six months, these latest developments will see prices begin to rise again.

There is a worldwide shortage of Aluminium so please be aware this may affect the products you use. Flashings on Velux, Fakro & Keylite windows are a few suppliers which have been affected.

Although other countries have gotten involved, the vast majority of Porcelain Paving is still manufactured in Italy, Spain, Poland, and Turkey. A large percentage of the raw material required to manufacture porcelain comes from Ukraine, and understandably this supply chain is now experiencing significant difficulties. Italy has already committed to a four-week shutdown of factories and a furloughing of workers due to the lack of raw material available, so we are anticipating shortages during the busy landscaping season.

Due to supply issues on some Marley products we have now introduced a new range of Breedon tiles to ensure our customers continue to get everything they need for their projects from Frank Key when they need it. We have also introduced a Thrutone equivalent to ensure a constant supply.
